Short Title: Assault in the Presence of Child.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT TO CREATE THE CRIMINAL OFFENSE OF ASSAULT IN THE 2 3 PRESENCE OF A CHILD. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 14-33(c) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read: 5 Unless the conduct is covered under some other provision of law providing 6 greater punishment, any person who commits any assault, assault and battery, or affray 7 8 is guilty of a Class A1 misdemeanor if, in the course of the assault, assault and battery, 9 or affray, he or she: 10 (7) Commits an assault with a deadly weapon or an assault that inflicts 11 serious injury on a person with whom he or she has a personal 12 relationship in the presence of a minor who is residing with or in the 13 custody of the person assaulted. The following definitions shall apply 14 15 in this subdivision: "In the presence of a minor" means: 16 a. In the physical presence of the minor; or 17 1. Having knowledge that a child is present and may see or 2. 18 19 hear the offense. "Minor" is as defined in G.S. 48A-2. 20 b. "Personal relationship" is as defined in G.S. 50B-1(b)." 21 SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2003, and applies to 22 offenses committed on or after that date. 23
