7	commits a violation of subdivision (c)(1) of this section on a person with whom the			
8	person has a personal relationship, and in the presence of a minor, shall be sentenced to			
9	an active punishment of no less than 30 days.

15			with or is under the care and supervision of, and	who has a
16			personal relationship with, the person assaulted or	the person
17			committing the assault.

19	(d) shall be sentenced to an active punishment of no less than 50 days."			
20	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective December 1, 2003, and applies to			
21	offenses comm	itted o	n or after that date.
