RESOLUTION 2003-17 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 1026

A JOINT RESOLUTION PROVIDING THAT THE 2003 GENERAL ASSEMBLY SHALL MEET IN JOINT SESSION TO COMMEMORATE THE 100^{TH} ANNIVERSARY OF ORVILLE AND WILBUR WRIGHT'S FIRST FLIGHT AND INVITING HIS EXCELLENCY, GOVERNOR MICHAEL F. EASLEY.

Whereas, on June 17, 1909, Orville and Wilbur Wright were awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor; and

Whereas, during the 100th anniversary of the Wright brothers' first flight, it is fitting that the General Assembly pay tribute to the Wright brothers during a joint session on this date; Now, therefore,

Be it resolved by the Senate, the House of Representatives concurring:

SECTION 1. On Tuesday, June 17, 2003, at 2:00 P.M., the Senate and the House of Representatives shall meet in joint session in the Hall of the Senate to commemorate the 100th anniversary of Orville and Wilbur Wright's first flight. **SECTION 2.** The Honorable Michael F. Easley, Governor, is invited to the

joint session.

SECTION 3. This resolution is effective upon ratification.
