A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 2 AN ACT AMENDING THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF WILMINGTON TO 3 ALLOW THE CITY MANAGER TO SETTLE CLAIMS AGAINST THE CITY 4 WHEN THE AMOUNT OF THE CLAIMS DO NOT EXCEED THE CITY'S 5 **INSURANCE DEDUCTIBLE.** The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 6 7 **SECTION 1.** Section 29.1 of the Charter of the City of Wilmington, being 8 Chapter 495 of the 1977 Session Laws, as amended by Chapter 617 of the 1981 Session 9 Laws, is repealed. 10 **SECTION 2.** Section 29.2 of the Charter of the City of Wilmington, being 11 Chapter 495 of the 1977 Session Laws, as amended by Chapter 617 of the 1981 Session 12 Laws, reads as rewritten: 13 "Sec. 29.2. Settlement of claims by city manager. The city manager may settle 14 claims against the city for: 15 (1)Personal injury or for damages to property when the amount involved does 16 not exceed the sum of twenty five hundred dollars (\$2500), two thousand five hundred 17 dollars (\$2,500) or such other amount approved by the city council, and does not exceed the actual loss sustained, including loss of time, medical expenses, and any other 18 expense actually incurred; and 19 20 (2)The taking of small portions of private property which are needed for street or utility rights-of-way, or rounding of corners at street intersections, or storm sewer 21 rights-of-way, when the amount involved in any such settlement does not exceed the 22 23 sum of twenty-five hundred dollars (\$2500), two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500) or such other amount approved by the city council, and does not exceed the actual loss 24 25 sustained. Settlement of a claim by the city manager pursuant to this section shall constitute a 26 complete release of the city from any and all damages sustained by the person involved 27 in such settlement in any manner arising out of the accident, occasion, or taking 28 complained of. All such releases shall be approved by the city attorney." 29
