5	SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-302.1 is amended by adding a new subsection to
6	read:
7	"(g1) Payment During Military Duty. – The State Board of Education shall adopt
8	rules relating to leaves of absence for short periods of military training and for State or
9	federal military duty or special emergency management service of all public school
10	teachers employed by local boards of education or by charter schools, without loss of
11	pay or time. The rules shall provide that (i) the State pays any salary differential to
12	teachers in State-funded positions, (ii) the employing local board of education pays any
13	pay differential to teachers in locally funded positions, (iii) the employing charter
14	school pays any pay differential to teachers in the charter school, and (iv) the employing
15	local board of education pays the local supplement."
16	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to all
17	school years beginning with the 2002-2003 school year.
