12	(3)	Sell, deliver and ship malt beverages in closed containers to	
13	,	wholesalers licensed under this Chapter as authorized by the ABC	
14		laws, except that malt beverages may be sold to exporters and	
15		nonresident wholesalers only when the purchase is not for resale in this	
16		State;	
17	(4)	Receive malt beverages manufactured by the permittee in some other	
18		state for transshipment to dealers in other states;	
19	(5)	Furnish or sell marketable malt beverage products, or packages which	
20		do not conform to the manufacturer's marketing standards, if State	
		taxes have been or will be paid, to its employees for the use of the

23	(6)	Give its products to its employees and guests for consumption on its	
24		premises;	
25	(7)	In areas where the sale is legal, sell the brewery's malt beverages at the

27		brewery also may obtain a malt beverage wholesaler permit to sell,	

1	deliver, and ship at wholesale only malt beverages manufactured by
2	the brewery. The authorization of this subdivision applies to a brewery
3	that sells, to consumers at the brewery, to wholesalers, to retailers, and
4	to exporters, fewer than 310,000 gallons25,000 barrels, as defined in
5	G.S. 81A-9, of malt beverages produced by it per year.
6	A sale or gift under subdivision (5) or (6) shall not be considered a retail or
7	wholesale sale under the ABC laws."
