AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES FOR OBESITY PREVENTION INITIATIVES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year, and the sum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year. These funds shall be used to create a national model for obesity prevention at the local community level. Funds shall be used to provide community grants working through local health departments to support community-based strategies for obesity prevention.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
