A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE SALT BLOCK FOUNDATION,
INC., FOR THE RENOVATION OF THE AUDITORIUM OF THE ARTS AND
SCIENCE CENTER OF CATAWBA VALLEY AND THE EXPANSION OF THE
CATAWBA SCIENCE CENTER.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

Short Title: Catawba Valley Salt Block Funds.

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Salt Block Foundation, a nonprofit corporation, the sum of two hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$225,000) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year to renovate the Arts and Science Center of Catawba Valley auditorium and the old Hickory High School shop building to provide additional space for the expansion of the Catawba Science Center, provided these funds are matched on the basis of one dollar (\$1.00) of non-State funds for every three dollars (\$3.00) of State funds.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
