| 5  | <b>SECTION 1.</b> Chapter 71A of the General Statutes is amended by adding a             |
| 6  | new section to read:   |
| 7  | "§ 71A-7.3. Nottoway Tribal Community; rights, privileges, immunities,                   |
| 8  | obligations, and duties.   |
| 9  | The Indians now residing in Hertford, Bertie, Gates, Northampton, and Martin             |
| 10 | Counties, who are lineal descendants of certain tribes of Indians, who originally        |
| 11 | inhabited areas along the Nottoway River in southeastern Virginia in precontact times    |
| 12 | shall, from and after July 20, 1971, be designated and officially recognized as the      |
| 13 | Nottoway Tribal Community of North Carolina, shall continue to enjoy all their rights,   |
| 14 | privileges, and immunities as citizens of the State as now or hereafter provided by law, |
| 15 | and shall continue to be subject to all the obligations and duties of citizens under the |
| 16 | <u>law.</u> "  |
| 17 | <b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.                             |
