4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 14 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a
6	new section to read:
7	" <u>§ 14-16.9A. Threats against school property.</u>
8	(a) Any person who knowingly and willfully makes any threat to damage or
9	harm the property of any school facility with the use of a firearm, explosives, or fire
10	shall be guilty of a Class I felony.
11	(b) Any person who knowingly and willfully makes any threat to damage or
12	harm the property of any school facility by means other than firearm, explosives, or fire
13	shall be guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor."
14	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2005, and applies to
15	offenses committed on or after that date.
