1 A HOUSE RESOLUTION PROVIDING THAT THE BUDGET MAY NOT BE
2 CONSIDERED IN THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES EARLIER THAN THE
3 DAY AFTER THE COMMITTEE REPORT.

4 Be it resolved by the House of Representatives:

5 **SECTION 1.** Rule 36(b) of the Permanent Rules of the House of
6 Representatives reads as rewritten:

7 "(b) **Favorable Report.** – When a standing committee or permanent
8 subcommittee reports a bill with the recommendation that it be passed, the bill shall be
9 placed on the favorable calendar on the day and in the order designated by the Chair of
10 the Standing Committee on Rules, Calendar, and Operations of the House, but no later
11 than the fourth legislative day after submission of the report or Senate message under
12 Rule 43.2 or Rule 43.3(a), unless:

13 (1) The bill is re-referred to the Committee on Appropriations or
14 Committee on Finance under Rule 38 or was serially referred under
15 Rule 32; or

16 (2) The bill has not yet been placed on the calendar, and the Speaker refers
17 the bill to another committee.

18 Notwithstanding the previous paragraph, neither the Current Operations
19 Appropriations bill nor a bill making general revisions in that act for the second fiscal
20 year of a biennium may be placed on the favorable calendar earlier than the next
21 legislative day after the committee reports the bill.

22 In order to place a bill on the calendar for a legislative day, notice shall be given by
23 the Chair of the Standing Committee on Rules, Calendar, and Operations of the House
24 orally in the House or in writing to the Principal Clerk. When a committee substitute is
25 adopted and receives a favorable report by the committee or permanent subcommittee,
26 the standing committee or permanent subcommittee chair shall submit to the standing
27 committee or permanent subcommittee the question of an unfavorable report on the

1 original bill. The standing committee's or permanent subcommittee's action, if any, on
2 the original bill shall be reported at the same time the committee substitute is reported."

3 **SECTION 2.** This resolution is effective upon adoption.
