A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA TO HELP ESTABLISH THE HICKORY CENTER FOR ENGINEERING TECHNOLOGY AND THE DEVELOPMENT OF ENGINEERING TECHNOLOGY PROGRAMS TO BE OFFERED BY THE CENTER.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of one million seven hundred sixty thousand dollars (\$1,760,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to help establish the Hickory Center for Engineering Technology and to support the use of two adjoining buildings in Hickory for the development of engineering technology programs. Of the funds appropriated by this act, the sum of one million one hundred thousand dollars (\$1,100,000) shall be used for nonrecurring costs, and the sum of six hundred sixty thousand dollars (\$660,000) shall be used for recurring costs.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
