A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO PLAN A NEW VETERINARY HOSPITAL
2 AT NORTH CAROLINA STATE UNIVERSITY.

4 Whereas, the North Carolina State University College of Veterinary Medicine
5 is the only veterinary college in the State and one of the highest ranked colleges of its
6 kind in the country; and

7 Whereas, the College's current 55,000 square foot Veterinary Teaching
8 Hospital opened in 1983 and was designed to accommodate a maximum of 12,000
9 animal accessions; and

10 Whereas, plans have been made to construct a new hospital adjacent to the
11 current facility, which will provide 115,000 square feet of clinical space and allow
12 expansion of current hospital services for companion animals; and

13 Whereas, the new hospital will be named for the late Randall B. Terry, Jr.,
14 whose Charitable Foundation gave North Carolina State University \$20,000,000 during
15 the University's \$1 billion Achieve! Campaign in 2005; and

16 Whereas, private donations totaling \$34,000,000 have been raised for the
17 construction of the new hospital; and

18 Whereas, State funds are needed to plan the new hospital; Now, therefore,
19 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

20 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
21 Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of seven million dollars
22 (\$7,000,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to be allocated to North Carolina State
23 University for use in planning the Randall B. Terry Companion Animal Veterinary
24 Medical Center at the University's College of Veterinary Medicine.

25 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
