A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE SUPPLEMENTAL FUNDING FOR LOW-WEALTH  
3 SCHOOL SYSTEMS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5       **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the  
6 Department of Public Instruction the sum of twenty million dollars (\$20,000,000) for  
7 the 2005-2006 fiscal year and the sum of forty million dollars (\$40,000,000) for the  
8 2006-2007 fiscal year for supplemental funding for low-wealth school systems.

9       **SECTION 2.** It is the goal of the General Assembly to provide an additional  
10 twenty million dollars (\$20,000,000) in funding for low-wealth school systems for the  
11 2007-2008 fiscal year to fully implement the funding formula for low-wealth  
12 supplemental funding.

13       **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
