4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. Article 14 of Chapter 116 of the General Statutes is amended
6	by adding a new section to read:
7	" <u>§ 116-143.7. Tuition surcharge.</u>
8	The Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina shall ensure that
9	procedures are established that are necessary to impose a one hundred percent (100%)
10	tuition surcharge on students who take more than 140 degree credit hours to complete a
11	baccalaureate degree in a four-year program or more than one hundred ten percent
12	(110%) of the credit hours necessary to complete a baccalaureate degree in any program
13	officially designated by the Board of Governors as a five-year program. The calculation
14	of these credit hours taken at a constituent institution or accepted for transfer shall
15	exclude hours earned through the College Board's Advanced Placement or CLEP
16	examinations, through institutional advanced placement or course validation, or through
17	summer term or extension programs. No surcharge shall be imposed on any student who
18	exceeds the degree credit hour limits within the equivalent of four academic years of
19	regular term enrollment, or within five academic years of regular term enrollment in a
20	degree program officially designated by the Board of Governors as a five-year
21	program."
22	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to all
22	

23 new undergraduates seeking a baccalaureate degree at a constituent institution.
