2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND
3	HUMAN SERVICES TO ADDRESS THE PUBLIC HEALTH AIDS CRISIS.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
6	Department of Health and Human Services the sum of three million three hundred
7	thousand dollars (\$3,300,000) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year and the sum of three million
8	three hundred thousand dollars (\$3,300,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year. These funds
9	shall be used to address the public health AIDS crisis through increased risk reduction,
10	prevention, and counseling and testing activities through local health departments,
11	community-based organizations, Historically Black Colleges and Universities, and HIV
12	Care Consortia. In allocating these funds, special emphasis shall be placed on reaching
13	populations disproportionately affected by HIV/AIDS.
14	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
