1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR HIGH-COST COMMUNITY COLLEGE PROGRAMS.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.(a)** The State Board of Community Colleges shall identify the Allied Health Programs within the Community College System and shall weight the costs of Allied Health Programs as a group against all other programs within the System. The State Board shall modify its funding formula to allow for differentiation in funding between Allied Health Programs and all other programs.

**SECTION 1.(b)** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Community Colleges System Office the sum of twenty-one million dollars (\$21,000,000) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year and the sum of twenty-one million dollars (\$21,000,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to provide for differentiated funding for Allied Health Programs.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
