5	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 160A-58.1(b) reads as rewritten:		
6	"(b) A 1	noncontiguous area proposed for annexation must meet all of the following

10		primary corporate limits of another city than to the primary corporate	
11		limits of the annexing city, except as set forth in subsection (b2) of this

13 14	 (5)	The area within the proposed satellite corporate limits, when added to	
14	(3)	the area within all other satellite corporate limits, may not exceed ten	
16		percent (10%) of the area within the primary corporate limits of the	
17		annexing city.

19		Concord, Conover, Gastonia, Hickory, Locust, Marion, Mount Airy,
