A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR AN EXHIBIT COMMEMORATING
THE SITTING OF THE FIRST TUBERCULOSIS RETREAT IN ASHEVILLE AS
PART OF THE CENTENNIAL CELEBRATION OF THE AMERICAN LUNG
ASSOCIATION.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the American Lung Association of North Carolina, a nonprofit corporation, the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year to create an exhibit commemorating the sitting of the first tuberculosis retreat in the Asheville area as part of the centennial celebration of the American Lung Association.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
