AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA FOR DENTAL SCHOOLS AT THE UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA AT CHAPEL HILL AND EAST CAROLINA UNIVERSITY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of seven million dollars (\$7,000,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year to develop further the joint plan for dental education and dental outreach in North Carolina developed by the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill and East Carolina University and approved by the Board of Governors to serve the needs of the citizens of the State. The plan endorses the expansion of the size of the dental school at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill and endorses the planning of a new dental school and outreach service/learning sites at East Carolina University, subject to program approval by the Board of Governors.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2006.
