A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE ELIOT HALL RESTORATION  
PROJECT AT PALMER MEMORIAL INSTITUTE.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Cultural Resources the sum of one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year and the sum of one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year for the restoration of Charles W. Eliot Hall on the historic campus of Palmer Memorial Institute, a facility of the Charlotte Hawkins Brown Museum.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
