1	A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2	AN ACT TO GIVE TEACHERS CREDIT FOR THE EXCESS PERSONAL LEAVE
3	TIME THAT THEY EARN AND TO ENSURE THAT TEACHERS CAN TAKE
4	PERSONAL LEAVE WITH FIVE DAYS' NOTICE.
5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. G.S. 115C-302.1(d) reads as rewritten:
7	"(d) Personal Leave. – Teachers earn personal leave at the rate of .20 days for
8	each full month of employment not to exceed two days per year. Personal leave may be
9	accumulated to a maximum of five days. without any applicable maximum until June 30
10	of each year. A teacher may carry forward to July 1 a maximum of five days of personal
11	leave; the remainder of the teacher's personal leave shall be converted to sick leave on
12	June 30. At the time of retirement, a teacher may also convert accumulated personal
13	leave to sick leave for creditable service towards retirement.
14	Personal leave may be used only upon the authorization of the teacher's immediate
15	supervisor, but supervisor. A teacher shall not take personal leave on the first day the
16	teacher is required to report for the school year, on a required teacher workday, or on
17	the day before or the day after a holiday or scheduled vacation day, unless the request is
18	approved by the principal. On all other days, if the request is made at least five days in
19	advance, the request shall be automatically granted and the teacher cannot be required to
20	provide a reason for the request. Unless approved by the principal, a teacher shall not
21	take personal leave on the first day the teacher is required to report for the school year,
22	on required teacher workdays, or on the day before or the day after holidays or
23	scheduled vacation days. Teachers may transfer personal leave days between local
24	school administrative units. The local school administrative unit shall credit a teacher
25	who has separated from service and is reemployed within 60 months from the date of
26	separation with all personal leave accumulated at the time of separation. Local school
27	administrative units shall not advance personal leave. Teachers using personal leave
28	receive full salary less the required substitute deduction."
29	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
