Short title. 11 This Article shall be known and may be cited as the North Carolina National Guard 12 Death Benefit and Dependent Higher Education Fund. 13 "§ 127A-211. Purpose. 14 15 The General Assembly of North Carolina finds that: The North Carolina National Guard has a proud tradition of military 16 (1) service with thousands of North Carolinians having answered the call 17 of the nation and served in the North Carolina National Guard. 18 Members of the North Carolina National Guard are now being asked to 19 <u>(2)</u> serve extended periods of active duty in combat areas. 20 Members of the North Carolina National Guard provide North 21 (3) 22 Carolina and its citizens valuable benefits through their service inside this State and through their recently extended periods of active duty in 23 combat areas outside North Carolina. 24 There have been instances in which dependents of members of the 25 (4)

North Carolina National Guard have been left without adequate
