A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND
HUMAN SERVICES TO SUPPORT ASTHMA EDUCATION ACTIVITIES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
Department of Health and Human Services the sum of two hundred fifty thousand
dollars (\$250,000) for the 2005-2006 fiscal year and the sum of two hundred fifty
thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 2006-2007 fiscal year. These funds shall be used to
support community-based organizations and local health department efforts to increase
education and awareness for controlling asthma.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2005.
