| 8  | <b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 113A-254(d) reads as rewritten:                                     |
| 9  | "(d) Wastewater Limits. – A wastewater collection system project or a wastewater           |
| 10 | treatment works project is eligible for a grant under this Article only if it is a         |
| 11 | high-unit-cost project, as defined in G.S. 159G-20. A planning grant or a technical        |
| 12 | assistance grant for a regional wastewater collection system or a regional wastewater      |
| 13 | treatment works is not subject to the high-unit-cost threshold. A grant made under this    |
| 14 | Article for a wastewater collection system project or a wastewater treatment works         |
| 15 | project is subject to the cost limits and recipient limits set in G.S. 159G-36 for a grant |
| 16 | awarded from the Wastewater Reserve."  |
| 17 | <b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to                 |
| 18 | applications for planning grants and technical assistance grants received by the Clean     |
| 19 | Water Management Trust Fund on or after 1 January 2007.                                    |
