8	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
9	SECTION 1. The following State agencies shall report to the State Energy		
10	Office of the De	partment of Administration no later than 1 October of each year on their	
11	activities and research related to greenhouse gas emissions and climate change:		
12	(1)	The Department of Administration.	
13	(2)	The Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services.	
14	(3)	The Department of Commerce.	
15	(4)	The Department of Crime Control and Public Safety.	
16	(5)	The Department of Environment and Natural Resources.	
17	(6)	The Department of Health and Human Services.	
18	(7)	The Department of Insurance.	
19	(8)	The Department of Revenue.	
20	(9)	The Department of Transportation.	
21	(10)	The Utilities Commission.	
22		FION 2. The reports required in Section 1 of this act shall include all of	
23	the following information:		
24	(1)	A description of any studies or research related to greenhouse gas	
25		emissions and climate change conducted by the agency.	
26	(2)	A description of planning by the agency related to greenhouse gas	
27	· · ·	emissions and climate change.	

1	(3)	A description of present and projected risks and vulnerabilities to the	
2		agency's areas of responsibility with regard to greenhouse gas	
3		emissions and climate change.	
4	(4)	A description of the agency's utilization of sources of information	
5		related to greenhouse gas emissions and climate change.	
6	(5)	A list of key personnel and offices in each agency related to	
7		greenhouse gas emissions and climate change.	
8	(6)	A list of recommendations to address present and projected risks and	
9		vulnerabilities to the agency's areas of responsibility with regard to	
10	SECT	greenhouse gas emissions and climate change.	
11		TION 3. The State Energy Office shall publish at least quarterly a	
12	newsletter that provides information on relevant research and models of State action		
13 14	related to greenhouse gas emissions and climate change to the key personnel and offices		
14 15	in each agency listed in Section 1 of this act. The State Energy Office shall post the neurolatter on the State Energy Office Web site and shall also distribute the neurolatter		
15 16	newsletter on the State Energy Office Web site and shall also distribute the newsletter		
10	electronically via the Internet.		
18	SECTION 4. The State Energy Office shall review the reports it receives pursuant to Section 1 of this act and prepare an annual assessment on the adequacy and		
19	general preparedness of State agencies with regard to greenhouse gas emissions and		
20	climate change. The State Energy Office shall report to the Governor, the General		
20	Assembly, and the Environmental Review Commission no later than 1 January of each		
22	year on its assessment of the adequacy and general preparedness of State agencies with		
23	regard to greenhouse gas emissions and climate change. The State Energy Office shall		
24	also distribute its annual assessment in the following formats:		
25	(1)	Distribute printed copies of the report to the agencies listed in Section	
26	(-)	1 of this act.	
27	(2)	Post the assessment on the State Energy Office Web site.	
28	(3)	Maintain printed copies of the assessment for inspection at the State	
29		Energy Office.	
30	(4)	Establish an interested parties electronic distribution list and distribute	
31		the assessment via the Internet.	
32	SECT	TON 5. The State agencies listed in Section 1 of this act shall submit	
33	the first reports i	required by Section 1 of this act to the State Energy Office on or before	
34	1 October 2008. The State Energy Office shall submit the first electronic newsletter		
35	required by Section 3 of this act on or before 1 January 2008. The State Energy Office		
36	shall submit the first report required by Section 4 of this act to the Governor, the		
37	General Assembly, and the Environmental Review Commission on or before 1 January		
38	2009.		
39	SECT	TON 6. This act is effective when it becomes law.
