SECTION 2. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
Department of Administration the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000)
for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000)
for the 2008-2009 fiscal year. These funds shall be used to support the Office of
Environmental Justice and to establish positions for a director, a technical specialist
with experience in environmental health or demographics, and an administrative
assistant.

**SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.

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
