The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. Funds appropriated to the Department of Health and Human

Services for the 2007-2008 fiscal year may be used to increase the maximum number of

assignments to special assistance in-home program to 2,000 persons.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
