2	pay a penalty of not more than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00).(\$25.00), even if more than		
3	one child less than 16 years of age are riding in the open bed or open cargo area of a		
4	vehicle. Conviction of an infraction under this section has no consequence other than		
5	payment of a penalty. A person found responsible for a violation of this section may not
