A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  AN ACT TO LIMIT LIABILITY FOR THE ACTS OF CERTIFIED CHILD PASSENGER SAFETY TECHNICIANS AND SPONSORING ORGANIZATIONS OF CHILD SAFETY SEAT EDUCATIONAL AND CHECKING PROGRAMS WHEN TECHNICIANS AND SPONSORING ORGANIZATIONS ARE ACTING IN GOOD FAITH AND CHILD SAFETY SEAT INSPECTIONS, INSTALLATION, ADJUSTMENT, OR EDUCATION PROGRAMS ARE PROVIDED WITHOUT FEE OR CHARGE, AS RECOMMENDED BY THE CHILD FATALITY TASK FORCE.  The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:  SECTION 1. Chapter 20 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read:  "§ 20-137.5. Child passenger safety technician; limitation of liability.  (a) The following definitions apply in this section:			
(1) (2)	Certified child passenger safety technician. — A certified passenger safety technician is an individual who has succe completed the U.S. Department of Transportation National H Traffic Safety Administration's (NHTSA) National Standardize Passenger Safety Certification Training Program and who main current child passenger safety technician or technician in certification through the current certifying body for the National Passenger Safety Training Program as designated by the N Highway Traffic Safety Administration.  Sponsoring organization. — A sponsoring organization is a perorganization other than a manufacturer of or employee or age manufacturer of child safety seats that:  a. Offers or arranges for the public a nonprofit child safety educational program, checkup event, or checking program utilizing certified child passenger safety technic	essfully ighway d Child ntains a structor d Child lational erson or ent of a ety seat station
