5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 160A-536(c) reads as rewritten:
7	"(c) Urban Area Revitalization Defined. – As used in this section, the term "urban
8	area revitalization projects" includes the provision within an urban area of any service
9	or facility that may be provided in a downtown area as a downtown revitalization
10	project under subdivision (a)(2) and subsection (b) of this section. As used in this
11	section, the term "urban area" means an area that (i) is located within a city whose
12	population exceeds 150,000 according to the most recent annual population statistics
13	certified by the State Budget Officer and (ii) meets one or more of the following
14	conditions:
15 16	<ol> <li>It is the central business district of the city.</li> <li>It consists primarily of existing or redevalating concentrations of</li> </ol>
10 17	(2) It consists primarily of existing or redeveloping concentrations of industrial, retail, wholesale, office, or significant
17	industrial, retail, wholesale, office, or significant employment-generating uses, or any combination of these uses.
18 19	(3) It is located in or along a major transportation corridor and does not
20	include any residential parcels that are not, at their closest point, within
20	150 feet of the major transportation corridor right-of-way or any
$\frac{21}{22}$	nonresidentially zoned parcels that are not, at their closest point,
22	within 1,500 feet of the major transportation corridor right-of-way.
24	(4) It has as its center and focus a major concentration of public or
25	institutional uses, such as airports, seaports, colleges or universities,
26	hospitals and health care facilities, or governmental facilities."
27	<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act is effective when it becomes law.
