7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
8	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 7A-304(a) is amended by adding a new subdivision to
9	read:
10	"§ 7A-304. Costs in criminal actions.
11	(a) In every criminal case in the superior or district court, wherein the defendant
12	is convicted, or enters a plea of guilty or nolo contendere, or when costs are assessed
13	against the prosecuting witness, the following costs shall be assessed and collected,
14	except that when the judgment imposes an active prison sentence, costs shall be
15	assessed and collected only when the judgment specifically so provides, and that no
16	costs may be assessed when a case is dismissed.

18	(2a) For the maintenance, renovation, construction, and purchase of State
19	judicial facilities, the sum of three dollars (\$3.00), to be remitted to the
20	Administrative Office of the Courts.

22	<b>SECTION 2.</b> G.S. 7A-305(a) is amended by adding a new subdivision to
23	read:
24	"§ 7A-305. Costs in civil actions.
25	(a) In every civil action in the superior or district court, except for actions
26	brought under Chapter 50B of the General Statutes, the following costs shall be
27	assessed:
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1 2 3	(1a) For the maintenance, renovation, construction, and purchase of State judicial facilities, the sum of three dollars (\$3.00), to be remitted to the Administrative Office of the Courts.
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5 6	<b>SECTION 3.</b> G.S. 7A-306(a) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:
7	"§ 7A-306. Costs in special proceedings.
8	(a) In every special proceeding in the superior court, the following costs shall be
9	assessed:

12	judicial facilities, the sum of three dollars (\$3.00), to be remitted to the
13	Administrative Office of the Courts.
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15	<b>SECTION 4.</b> G.S. 7A-307(a) is amended by adding a new subdivision to

18 19	(a) In the administration of the estates of decedents, minors, incompetents, of missing persons, and of trusts under wills and under powers of attorney, in trust
20	proceedings under G.S. 36A-23.1, and in collections of personal property by affidavit,

23	(1a) For the maintenance, renovation, construction, and purchase of State
24	judicial facilities, the sum of three dollars (\$3.00), to be remitted to the
25	Administrative Office of the Courts.
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27	SECTION 5. Article 29 of Chapter 7A of the General Statutes is amended
28	by adding a new section to read:
29	" <u>§ 7A-343.4. Judicial Branch Facilities Reserve Fund.</u>
30	The Judicial Branch Facilities Reserve Fund is established within the Judicial
31	Department as a nonreverting, interest-bearing special revenue account. Accordingly,
32 33	revenue in the Fund at the end of a fiscal year does not revert and interest and other
33 34	investment income earned by the Fund shall be credited to it. State facilities fees collected or reserved by the Director pursuant to G.S. 7A-304, 7A-305, 7A-306,
34 35	7A-307, and 143-4-2.1 shall be remitted to the State Treasurer and held in this Fund.
36	Moneys in the Fund shall be available to the Judicial Branch for maintenance,
37	renovations, repairs, construction, and purchase of State Judicial Branch land and
38	facilities. The Director shall report by August 1 and February 1 of each year to the Joint
39	Legislative Commission on Governmental Operations, the Chairs of the Senate and
40	House Appropriations Committees, and the Chairs of the Senate and House
41	Appropriations Subcommittees on Justice and Public Safety on all moneys collected and
42	deposited in the Fund during the preceding six months of the fiscal year and on the
43	proposed expenditure of those funds."

## General Assembly of North Carolina

1	SECTION 6. Article 4 of Chapter 143C of the General Statutes is amended
2	by adding a new section to read:
3	"§ 143C-4-2.1. Judicial Branch Facilities Reserve.
4	(a) Creation and Source of Funds. – The Judicial Branch Facilities Reserve is
5	established as a reserve account within the Judicial Branch. State facilities fees paid as
6	part of court costs for the General Court of Justice shall be placed in the Judicial Branch
7	Facilities Reserve. The Administrative Officer of the Courts may further transfer to the
8	Judicial Branch Facilities Reserve one-fourth of the unexpended, unencumbered balance
9	of an appropriation, as determined on a cash basis, remaining in the Judicial Branch
10	budget at the end of each fiscal year.
11	(b) Nonreverting Funds. – The Judicial Branch Facilities Reserve established
12	within the Judicial Department is a nonreverting, interest-bearing special revenue
13	account. Accordingly, revenue in the account at the end of a fiscal year does not revert
14	and interest and other investment income earned by the Fund shall be credited to it. All
15	State facilities moneys collected or reserved by the Director pursuant to G.S. 7A-304,
16	7A-305, 7A-306, 7A-307, and subsection (a) of this section shall be remitted to the
17	State Treasurer and held in this Fund.
18	(c) Use of Funds. – Moneys in the Fund shall be available to the Judicial Branch
19	for maintenance, renovations, repairs, construction, purchase, and payments toward any
20	certificates of participation for State Judicial Branch facilities and land. The Director
21	shall report by August 1 and February 1 of each year to the Joint Legislative
22	Commission on Governmental Operations, the Chairs of the Senate and House
23	Appropriations Committees, and the Chairs of the Senate and House Appropriations
24	Subcommittees on Justice and Public Safety on all moneys collected and deposited in
25	the Fund during the preceding six months of the fiscal year and on the proposed
26	expenditure of those funds."
27	<b>SECTION 7.</b> Certificates of participation may be sold by the State
28	Treasurer, in accordance with the State Capital Facilities Finance Act in Chapter 142 of
29	the General Statutes, in the manner, either at public or private sale, and for any price or
30	prices, that the State Treasurer determines to be in the best interest of the State to effect
31	the purchase of State judicial facilities located at 901 Corporate Drive, Raleigh, N.C.
32	and more particularly described as Phase Two, Tract A of Raleigh Corporate Center
33	consisting of 17.28 acres and as shown on map recorded in Map book 1987, page 720
34 25	and Map book 1990, page 576 of the Wake County Register of Deeds.
35	<b>SECTION 8.</b> This act becomes effective July 1, 2007, and applies to all
36	costs assessed or paid on or after that date.
