- 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the 7 Department of Public Instruction the sum of two million two hundred eighty-one 8 thousand dollars (\$2,281,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of two million two hundred eighty-one thousand dollars (\$2,281,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to 9 give public school students the opportunity to take the SAT Test one time at State 10 11 expense. To qualify to take the test at State expense, a student must provide proof that he or she has completed a Free Application for Student Financial Aid, as provided by 12 13 the United States Department of Education. 14 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
