A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO PROVIDE AN EXCEPTION TO THE DEVELOPMENT TIER  
DESIGNATION FORMULA FOR CERTAIN SMALL COUNTIES WITH HIGH  
POVERTY RATES.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 143B-437.08(e) reads as rewritten:

"(e) Adjustment for Certain Small Counties. – Regardless of the actual  
development factor, ~~any~~ the following adjustment shall apply:

(1) Any county that has a population of less than 12,000 shall  
automatically be ranked one of the 40 highest ~~counties,~~ anycounties.

(2) Any county that has a population of less than 50,000 shall  
automatically be ranked one of the 80 highest ~~counties,~~ counties.

(3) Any county that has a population of less than 20,000 and more than  
seventeen percent (17%) of its population below the federal poverty  
level according to the most recent federal decennial census shall  
automatically be ranked one of the 40 highest counties.

(4) ~~and any~~ Any county that has a population of less than 50,000 and more  
than nineteen percent (19%) of its population below the federal  
poverty level according to the most recent federal decennial census  
shall automatically be ranked one of the 40 highest counties."

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law and applies to  
designations made on or after that date.
