A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR AN ADDITIONAL DEPUTY CLERK POSITION FOR GRANVILLE COUNTY TO HANDLE THE ADDITIONAL CASELOAD RESULTING FROM THE OPENING OF CENTRAL REGIONAL HOSPITAL IN BUTNER AND TO DIRECT THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES TO ASSIGN A COMPETENCY HEARING COORDINATOR TO CENTRAL REGIONAL HOSPITAL IN BUTNER.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial Department the sum of thirty-nine thousand five hundred fifty-two dollars (\$39,552) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of thirty-seven thousand four hundred eighty dollars (\$37,480) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to establish an additional deputy clerk position for Granville County in order to handle an increase in involuntary commitments and guardianship cases resulting from the opening of Central Regional Hospital in Butner.

**SECTION 2.** The Department of Health and Human Services shall assign a competency hearing coordinator to Central Regional Hospital in Butner upon the hospital's opening.

**SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
