2	AN ACT TO PROHIBIT DISABLED VETERANS FROM BEING CHARGED FOR
3	ACCESS TO, OR FOR THE USE OF PUBLIC SERVICE FACILITIES OR
4	CONVENIENCES WITHIN, STATE FORESTS, STATE PARKS, STATE
5	LAKES, AND OTHER AREAS UNDER THE CHARGE OF THE DEPARTMENT
6	OF ENVIRONMENT AND NATURAL RESOURCES.
7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
8	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 113-35 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
9	"(b2) No disabled veteran shall pay any fee for access to any State forest, State
10	park, State lake, or other area under the Department's charge or for the use of any public
11	service facility or convenience within a State forest, State park, State lake, or other area
12	under the Department's charge. As used in this subsection, the term 'disabled veteran'
13	means a person who is a fifty percent (50%) or more disabled veteran as determined by
14	the United States Department of Veterans Affairs."
15	<b>SECTION 2.</b> G.S. 113-35(b) reads as rewritten:
16	"(b) The Department may construct, operate, and maintain within the State forests,
17	State parks, State lakes, and other areas under its charge suitable public service facilities
18	and conveniences, and may may, subject to subsection (b2) of this section, charge and
19	collect reasonable fees for the use of these facilities and conveniences. The Department
20	may also charge and collect reasonable fees for each of the following:
21	(1) The erection, maintenance, and use of docks, piers, and any other
22	structures permitted in or on State lakes under rules adopted by the
23	Department.
24	(2) Hunting privileges on State forests and fishing privileges in State
25	forests, State parks, and State lakes, provided that these privileges shall
26	be extended only to holders of State hunting and fishing licenses who
27	comply with all State game and fish laws.

1	(3) Vehicle access for off-road driving at the beach at Fort Fisher State
2	Recreation Area.
3	(4) The erection, maintenance, and use of a marina at Carolina Beach."
4	<b>SECTION 3.</b> This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
