1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE EDGECOMBE/NASH CENTER 3 FOR FAMILY GROWTH AND DEVELOPMENT. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Edgecombe/Nash Center for Family Growth and Development Inc., a nonprofit 6 7 organization, the sum of three hundred fifty-four thousand dollars (\$354,000) for the 8 2007-2008 fiscal year. Theses funds shall be allocated as follows: 9 (1) \$60,000 to the Edgecombe Nash Center for Family Growth and Development to provide support and funding for innovative 10 11 programming for residents and clients, education training and professional development opportunities for affected citizens and staff, 12 13 research activities, and state-of-the-art knowledge and activities to attract students and workers into health and social services 14 15 occupations. 16 (2) \$80,000 for Single Women in Mission, a nonprofit organization, to 17 support single women and children through its mentoring and domestic 18 violence prevention program. \$100,000 for The Wright's Center, a nonprofit organization providing 19 (3) day health care services to disabled adults. 20 21 \$114,000 for Crosswork, Inc., a nonprofit organization providing (4)
