A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE COLLEGE OF VETERINARY
3	MEDICINE CLINICAL TEACHING AND RESEARCH FUND.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of 6 Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of five hundred thousand 7 dollars (\$500,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to be allocated to North Carolina State 8 University for the College of Veterinary Medicine Clinical Teaching and Research 9 Fund. These funds shall be used as follows:

10	(1)	To allow advanced diagnostic and treatment options for animals of all
11		species presented to the College of Veterinary Medicine Teaching
12		Hospitals and Services where either the (i) owner financing of such
13		options are limited, (ii) significant instructional value exists, or (iii) the
14		conduct of such diagnostic and treatment options has the potential of
15		adding significantly to core knowledge in the relevant clinical area.

- 16 (2) To allow establishment and support of a Veterinary Clinical Trials 17 Program aimed at generating new, clinically relevant knowledge 18 across multiple species by assessment of the efficacy of novel 19 diagnostics, therapeutics, and treatment modalities in a broad 20 population of the relevant species.
- 21 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
