The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
<b>SECTION 1</b> . Notwithstanding the provisions of G.	S. 115D-15.1(c),
G.S. 143-341(3)a., or any other provision of law pertaining to capita	l improvements,
Richmond Community College may, in collaboration with the City of	Laurinburg, use
State grant funds to construct an approximately 18,000 square foot build	ding on property
owned by the City of Laurinburg located at 600 McLean Street in L	aurinburg. The
facility shall consist of college classrooms, office space, and laborate	ories. Upon the
completion of the facility, the property and building shall be transferr	ed to Richmond
Community College.	
If at any time the City terminates the transfer of property	v, the City shall
reimburse to Richmond Community College a prorated amount of	the State funds

reimburse to Richmond Community College a prorated amount of the State funds provided for the construction.

SECTION 2. Except for G.S. 143-128.2 and G.S. 143-128.3, the provisions of Article 8 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes shall not apply to the renovation of the facility. 

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law and expires December 31, 2011.
