The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the
Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, the sum of three
hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year. These funds shall
be allocated in the following amounts:
(1) \$150,000 to provide vision screening for children enrolled in the
More at Four preschool program.
(2) \$150,000 to support critical needs in the Kenneth Royall Vision
Screening Program to meet additional demands for training and
materials resulting from increased early childhood vision screening
requirements.
SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
