7	SECTION 1. Chapter 20 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a
8	new section to read:
9	"§ 20-137.5. Child passenger safety technician; limitation of liability.
10	(a) <u>Certified Child Passenger Safety Technician. – A certified child passenger</u>
11	safety technician is an individual who has successfully completed the U.S. Department
12	of Transportation, National Highway Traffic Safety Administration's (NHTSA)
13	National Standardized Child Passenger Safety Certification Training Program and who
14	maintains a current child passenger safety technician or technician instructor
15	certification through the current certifying body for the National Child Passenger Safety
16	Training Program as designated by the National Highway Traffic Safety
17	Administration.
18	(b) Limitation of Liability. – A certified child passenger safety technician or
19	sponsoring organization shall not be liable to any person as a result of any act or
20	omission that occurs solely in the inspection, installation, or adjustment of a child safety
21	seat, or in providing education regarding the installation or adjustment of a child safety
22	seat if the child passenger safety technician or sponsoring organization acts in good
23	faith and within the scope of training for which the technician is currently certified,
24	unless the act or omission constitutes willful and wanton misconduct or gross
25	negligence."
26	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2008.
