A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO ALLOW THE TOWN OF CHAPEL HILL TO REGULATE OR
2 PROHIBIT NEW IRRIGATION SYSTEMS FOR RESIDENTIAL AND
3 NONRESIDENTIAL DEVELOPMENTS USED FOR LAWNS AND
4 LANDSCAPING THAT ARE CONNECTED TO THE PUBLIC POTABLE
5 WATER SUPPLY.

7 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

8 **SECTION 1.** A municipality may by ordinance regulate or prohibit, in new
9 subdivisions and other residential and nonresidential development, irrigation systems
10 for lawns and other landscaping which are connected to the local potable water supply
11 system.

12 **SECTION 2.** This act applies to the Town of Chapel Hill only.

13 **SECTION 3.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
