A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE
UNIVERSITY OF NORTH CAROLINA TO CONSTRUCT AN ACADEMIC
BUILDING FOR THE COLLEGE OF EDUCATION AT APPALACHIAN STATE
UNIVERSITY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Board of
Governors of The University of North Carolina the sum of thirty-four million dollars
(\$34,000,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to be allocated to Appalachian State
University to construct an academic building for the College of Education. The facility
will contain classrooms, computer labs, offices for faculty and staff, clinical space to
serve the program needs related to counseling and communication disorders, and
adequate space to increase the number of newly trained K-12 teachers in North
Carolina.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
