1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR ELECTION OF MEMBERS OF THE WAKE COUNTY 3 BOARD OF EDUCATION AT-LARGE, AND TO MOVE THOSE ELECTIONS TO THE EVEN-NUMBERED YEAR, TO BE ELECTED IN NOVEMBER ON A 4 5 PLURALITY BASIS. 6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. Section 7 of Chapter 717, Session Laws of 1975, as amended 7 8 by Sections 2 and 3 of Chapter 321, Session Laws of 1977, and as rewritten by Section 9 3 of Chapter 742 of the 1981 Session Laws, reads as rewritten: "Sec. 7.(a) In 1981, 2008 and biennially thereafter, members of the Wake County 10 Board of Education shall be elected by the nonpartisan election and runoff-plurality 11 election method in accordance with G.S. 163-279(a)(4), G.S. 163-293, and 12 G.S. G.S. 163-279(a)(1), 163-292, and 163-294.2. 163-294.2, except that only persons 13 14 who are registered to vote in the district shall be permitted to file a notice of candidacy 15 for election in that district. Such election shall be governed by the provisions of Chapter 16 163 of the General Statutes. 17 The qualified voters of each district shall elect a person who resides in that (b)18 district for the seat apportioned to that district. Only the qualified voters of the district may vote in that election. The qualified voters of the entire county shall elect all 19 20 members of the board at-large." 21 **SECTION 2.** Section 6 of Chapter 717, Session Laws of 1975, as amended 22 by Section 1 of Chapter 321, Session Laws of 1977, and as rewritten by Section 3 of 23 Chapter 742 of the 1981 Session Laws, reads as rewritten: 24 "Sec. 6. All terms of office of members of the Wake County Board of Education 25 shall begin on the first Monday in December following their election. Districts 1, 2, 7, 26 and 9 shall elect a member in 1981 Four members shall be elected in 2010 and quadrennially thereafter for a four-year term. Districts 3, 4, 5, 6, and 8 shall elect a 27

1 member in 1981 for a two-year term and in 1983 Five members shall be elected in 2008 2 and quadrennially thereafter for a four-year term." 3 SECTION 3. The terms of office of members of the Wake County Board of 4 Education elected in 2003 for terms to expire in 2007 are extended until the first 5 Monday in December of 2008. The terms of office of members of the Wake County 6 Board of Education elected in 2005 for terms to expire in 2009 are extended until the 7 first Monday in December of 2010. 8 SECTION 4. Section 5 of Chapter 717, Session Laws of 1975, as rewritten 9 by Chapter 742 of the 1981 Session Laws, is repealed. When a vacancy is filled for 10 terms expiring in 2008 and 2010, the replacement member must reside in the district 11 from which the vacating member had been elected in 2003 or 2005. 12 **SECTION 5.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
