Short Title: Broughton Hospital CT Scanner Funds. (Public) Senators Dalton and Jacumin. **Sponsors:** Referred to: Appropriations/Base Budget. March 1, 2007 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO ALLOW BROUGHTON HOSPITAL TO PURCHASE A USED CT SCANNER. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Mental Health, Developmental Disabilities, and Substance Abuse Services, the sum of two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to be allocated to Broughton Hospital for the purchase of a used CT (computed tomography) scanner.

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
