A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO ELIMINATE THE REQUIREMENT OF THREE HUNDRED  
2 APPLICATIONS BEFORE THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES IS  
3 AUTHORIZED TO PRODUCE THE GOLD STAR LAPEL BUTTON PLATE.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-79.4(b)(54) reads as rewritten:

6 "(b) Types. – The Division shall issue the following types of special registration  
7 plates:

8 ...

9 (54) Gold Star Lapel Button. – Issuable to the recipient of the Gold Star  
10 lapel button. The plate shall bear the emblem of the Gold Star lapel  
11 button and the words "Gold Star". ~~The Division may not issue the plate  
12 authorized by this subdivision unless it receives at least 300  
13 applications for the plate.~~

14 ...."

15 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
