| 8 | SECTION 1. Article 36 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes is amended |
| 9 | by adding a new Part to read: |
| 10 | "Part 4. NC Green Business Fund. |
| 11 | " <u>§ 143-345.19. NC Green Business Fund established as a special revenue fund.</u> |
| 12 | (a) Establishment. – The NC Green Business Fund is established as a special |
| 13 | revenue fund in the Department of Administration. The State Energy Office is |
| 14 | responsible for administering the Fund. |
| 15 | (b) Purposes. – Moneys in the NC Green Business Fund shall be allocated |
| 16 | pursuant to this subsection. The State Energy Office shall make grants from the Fund to |
| 17 | private business with less than 100 employees, nonprofit organizations, local |
| 18 | governments, and State agencies to encourage the expansion of small- to medium-size |
| 19 | businesses with less than 100 employees to help grow a green economy in the State. |
| 20 | Moneys in the NC Green Business Fund shall be used for projects that will focus on the |
| 21 | following three priority areas: |
| 22 | (1) To encourage the development of the bio-fuels industry in the State. |
| 23 | The State Energy Office shall make grants available to maximize |
| 24 | development, production, distribution, retail infrastructure, and |
| 25 | consumer purchase of bio-fuels in North Carolina, including workforce |
