8	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
9	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 14-202.1(b) reads as rewritten:
10	"(b) Taking indecent liberties with children is punishable as a Class F felony. Class
11	<u>E felony.</u> "
12	<b>SECTION 2.</b> G.S. 14-202.4(a) reads as rewritten:
13	"(a) If a defendant, who is a teacher, school administrator, student teacher, school
14	safety officer, or coach, at any age, or who is other school personnel and is at least four
15	years older than the victim, takes indecent liberties with a victim who is a student, at
16	any time during or after the time the defendant and victim were present together in the
17	same school but before the victim ceases to be a student, the defendant is guilty of a
18	Class I felony, Class G felony unless the conduct is covered under some other provision
19	of law providing for greater punishment. A person is not guilty of taking indecent
20	liberties with a student if the person is lawfully married to the student."
21	<b>SECTION 3.</b> This act becomes effective December 1, 2007, and applies to
22	offenses committed on or after that date.
