Fifteen years. 8 No action for the recovery of damages for personal injury, death, or damage to property based upon or arising out of any alleged defect or any failure in relation to a 9 10 product shall be brought more than fifteen years after the date of initial purchase for use or consumption." 11 12 **SECTION 2.** G.S. 1-50(a)(6) is repealed. **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007, and applies to causes 13 14 of action arising on or after that date; provided, however, this act shall not apply to a

cause of action involving a product initially purchased for use or consumption prior to
