BILL SUMMARY:

The Proposed Committee Substitute for Senate Bill 103 does the following:

- > It authorizes the Division of Motor Vehicles to develop five new special registration plates.
- It eliminates the requirement of 300 applications before DMV is authorized to produce the Gold Star special plate.
- It changes the recipient of funds from the Omega Psi Phi special plate from the United Negro College Fund to the Carolina Uplift Foundation for youth activity and scholarship programs.
- It eliminates the additional fee amount for the Breast Cancer Awareness plate. However, this bill also authorizes a new special plate for 'Breast Cancer Early Detection' that will require the same additional fee amount, which will be directed to the same organization as under current law.

ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY:

The Omega Psi Phi Plate changes the recipient of funds and therefore has no net impact on revenues.

The Gold Star Plate eliminates the minimum number of applicants necessary before issuance and therefore has no net impact on revenues.

The Breast Cancer Awareness Plate is in addition to an existing plate which does not contain additional pass through fees designated for the specified cause. The applicants will have the choice whether to purchase the plate with or the plate without the fee. Fiscal Research has no means to determine how many applicants will elect to pay the additional fee.

The Prostate Cancer Awareness Plate is new and will require the \$10 special registration fee with no additional fee. Fiscal Research has means to determine how many individuals will apply for this plate.

The Juvenile Diabetes Research Plate is new and will require the \$10 special registration fee as well as a \$20 pass through fee. Fiscal Research has means to determine how many individuals will apply for this plate.

The Hospice Care Plate is new and will require the \$10 special registration fee as well as a \$30 pass through fee. Fiscal Research has means to determine how many individuals will apply for this plate.
